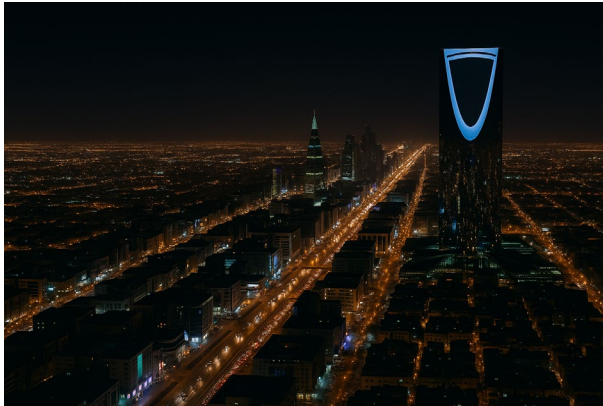
Figure 1. Vision 2030 – Saudi Arabia's blueprint for national transformation.

Achievements Since 2016

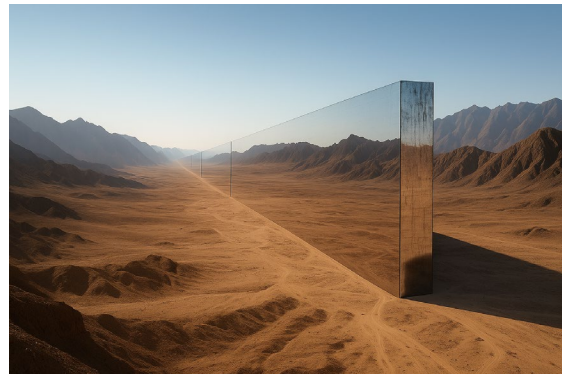
Since the launch of Vision 2030, Saudi Arabia has undergone profound social and economic change. Notable achievements include:

Through SDAIA and Vision 2030 programs, Saudi Arabia became a leader in AI, smart governance, and e-services.

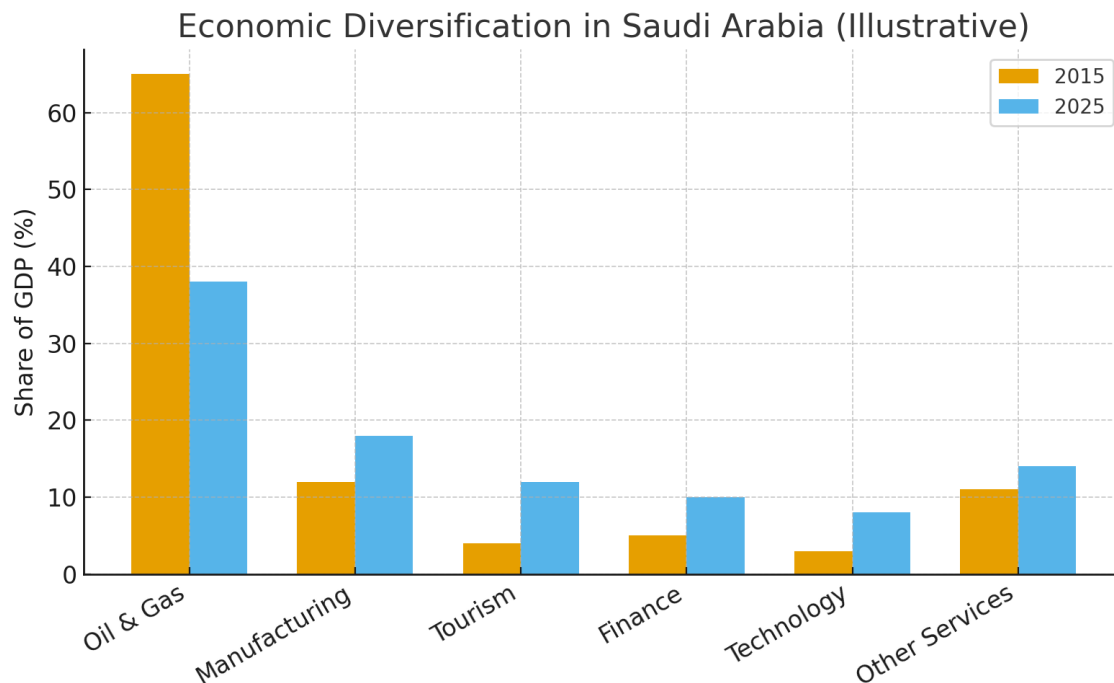


Figure 2. Shift in Saudi Arabia’s economic composition between 2015 and 2025.

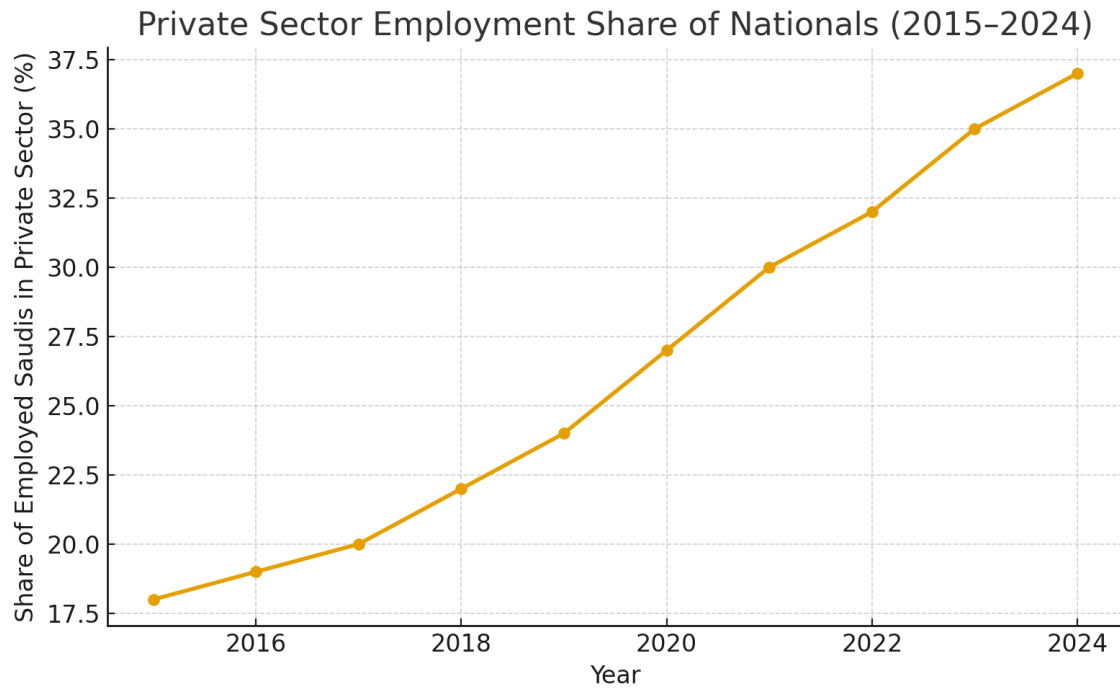


Figure 3. Increase in private sector employment among Saudi nationals (2015-2024).

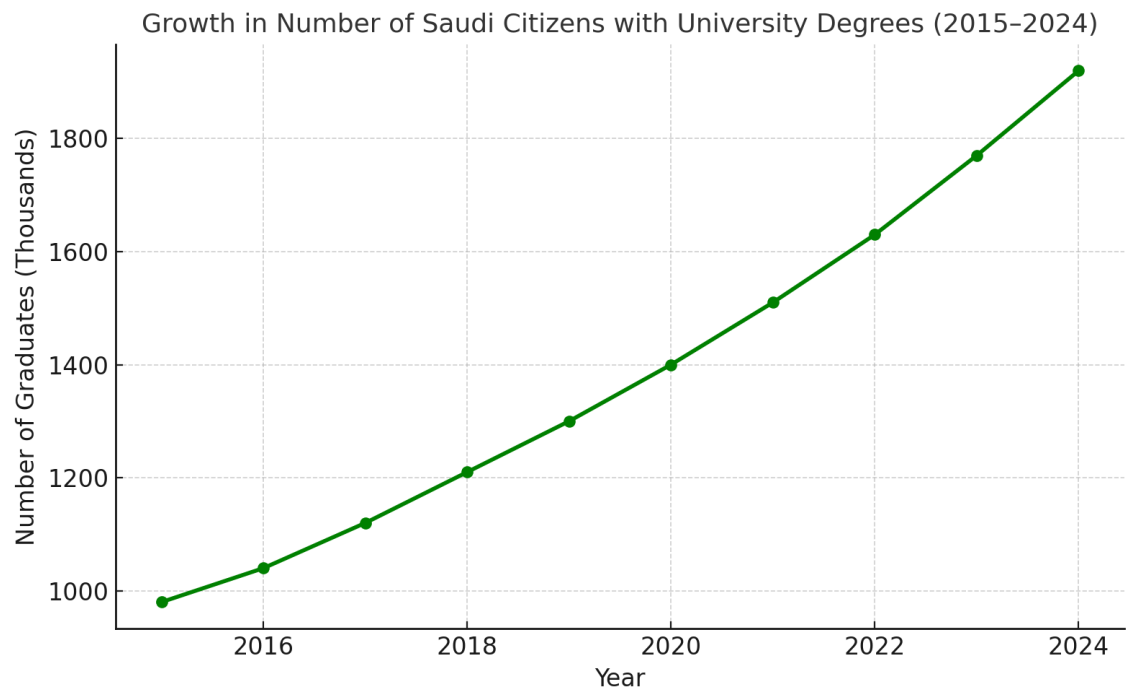


Figure 4. Growth in Graduate Numbers in Saudi Arabia.
